

Virgin Atlantic Airways Engineering Apprenticeship Scheme

This is a 3-year apprenticeship that covers all modules required for EASA Part 66 Cat A, and B1 or B2 licences (dependant upon the Company requirement).

Minimum qualifications are:

4 x GCSE's Grade C or above in **all** of the following subjects:

- English Language
- Maths
- Science
- + One other.

You must hold certificates in these subjects (**not predicted grades**) at the time of application. The apprenticeship is primarily based at Gatwick, with some work experience carried out at Heathrow.

You must have the right to live and work unrestricted in the UK. You must be able to provide supporting documentation to the above at the time of application e.g. UK passport.
